The villages are free from the hustle and bustle of a city life. It is formed, governed and maintained by its villagers. To govern or to run means to control and to look after its people. But every state has hundreds of villages and towns. So, it is not possible for the state government to know what the people of every village and town needs. That is why villages and towns have their own local government called Gram Panchayat. It is an agency which looks after the needs of the villagers. The word Panchayat means a committee of five persons. The head of the panchayat is called the Pradhan or Sarpanch.
